State of the Union Address – Washington, DC

Current Situation: On Mar 7, the President will deliver the State of the Union Address to a Joint Session of Congress in Washington, DC. The event has been designated a National Special Security Event; FEMA has primary responsibility for the coordination of federal emergency management planning.



- MERS providing communications and mobile command post functions to Region III and other federal agencies










National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Hazards Outlook – Mar 7-11







Public Assistance (PA) Grant Program Activity – per Region






