








# Hurricane Delta PEAK STORM SURGE FORECAST









### Hurricane Delta – Preparations/Response



**Situation:** Hurricane Delta threats portions of the Gulf Coast. Personnel and resources are staged across, or en-route to, potentially impacted areas in the path of the storm.



#### State/Local Preparations and Response

- AL EOC at Partial Activation (TC Delta & COVID-19); Governor declared State of Emergency; EM requested
- MS EOC at Partial Activation (COVID-19); Governor declared State of Emergency; EM requested
  - o MS National Guard activated
- FL EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)


 LA EOC at Partial Activation (TC Delta & COVID-19); Governor declared State of Emergency; EM approved





## COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 33 (-2) states/territories, with 8 (+2) states/territories in a plateau status, and 16 states/territories on a downward trajectory. 16,763 National Guard deployed / activated; 1,253 (-13) FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 7)

Nationwide Testing: 120,916,780 (+1,533,466) cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 7)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally

United States: 7,475,262Worldwide: 35,537,491


Deaths caused by COVID-19




