




DAY 1 CONVECTIVE OUTLOOK



3 DAY RAINFALL



Situation: At approximately 7:00 p.m. ET last evening, Hurricane Delta made landfall near Creole, LA as a CAT 2 hurricane and has continued to weaken. Response and Recovery efforts continue with personnel and resources staged across the storm track.

Lifeline Impacts: (FEMA NRCC SLB, as of 6:00 a.m. ET, Oct 10)

Safety and Security

- LA: Mandatory / voluntary evacuations in effect for 26 parishes
- MS: Mandatory evacuations in effect for 1 county

Food, Water, Shelter

- Meals, water, tarps, and plastic sheeting pre-staged within Region IV & VI; No unmet needs
- LA: 6 drinking water systems serving a population of 4.6k are inoperable; 3 systems under boil water advisories
- LA:
 - o 6 congregate shelters / 933 occupants
 - o 12 non-congregate shelters / 8.6k occupants
- MS: 3 congregate shelters on standby / 0 occupants

Health and Medical


- LA: COVID-19 testing sites closed; plan to resume testing today
- LA: 31 medical facilities evacuated or sheltering in place

Energy (Eagle I as of 7:45 a.m. ET, Oct 10)

- LA: 536k (25%) customers without power
 - o 7,500 utility workers on standby for restoration with another 8,000 available
- MS: 87k (7%) customers without power

Transportation

- · LA Port status:
 - Closures: Lake Charles, Cameron, Morgan City, Houma, Intracoastal City, Port Fourchon, and Offshore Oil
 - Open w/restrictions: Baton Rouge, New Orleans, Plaquemines, and South Louisiana






Inland Flood Threat



COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 27 (-2) states/territories, with 13 (+3) states/territories in a plateau status, and 16 (-1) states/territories on a downward trajectory; 1,231 (-4) FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 9)

Nationwide Testing: 123,094,477 (+1,155,579) cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 9)


COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally

- COVID-19 Confirmed Cases:
 - United States: 7,583,200 (+54,887)
 - o Worldwide: 36,237,403 (+334,693)
- COVID-19 Associated Deaths:
 - United States: 212,111 (+979)
 - o Worldwide: 1,054,868 (+6,060) (COVID-19 Response Update, as of Oct 9)

Response:



FEMA-3547-EM-LA	1		Adds 6 parishes for reimbursement for eligible emergency protective measures (already designated for emergency protective measures (Category B), limited to direct Federal assistance assistance)
FEMA-4563-DR-AL	2	Oct 9	Adds 3 counties for permanent work [Categories C-G] (already designated for Individual Assistance and assistance for debris removal and emergency protective measures [Categories A and B], including direct federal assistance, under the Public Assistance program.) Adds 1 county for Public Assistance, including direct federal assistance
