




# Atlantic Overview TROPICAL OUTLOOK




# Tropical Storm Eta SATELLITE LOOP




## Tropical Storm Eta RADAR LOOP




## Tropical Storm Eta FORECAST TRACK




## Tropical Storm Eta MOST LIKELY ARRIVAL OF TS WINDS



# Tropical Storm Eta PEAK STORM SURGE FORECAST





## **Tropical Storm Eta – Preparations / Response**

<u>Situation</u>: TS Eta is making landfall near Cedar Key, FL and is expected to move across northeastern FL today before passing into the western Atlantic

<u>Lifeline Impacts</u>: (Source: Region IV Spot Report Update 5, as of 6:00 a.m. ET) Safety & Security:

- Hernando and Manatee counties under voluntary evacuations
- Several county schools and Government Offices closed

#### Food, Water, & Sheltering:

14 shelters open in 5 counties with 50 occupants

#### Health & Medical:

Pasco County, FL COVID-19 Testing site closed

#### Energy:

■ 51K customers without power (Eagle-I as of 7:00 a.m.)

#### Transportation:


- Tampa and Sarasota-Bradenton International Airports closed; Tampa permitting emergency operations
- Sunshine Skyway Bridge closed due to high winds
- Ports of Tampa, Manatee, and St. Petersburg closed

#### State/Local Preparations and Response:

FL EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19 & TS Eta); Gov declared State of Emergency

#### FEMA/Federal Preparations and Response:

- NWC Enhanced Watch Rostered; NRCC at Level III (COVID-19)
- Region IV RWC at Enhanced Watch (day shift); RRCC Rostered
- Region IV IMAT-1 deployed to MS (Tropical Cyclone Zeta); IMAT-2 available



### **COVID-19 Update**

<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 50 states/territories, with 2 jurisdiction in a plateau status, and 3 jurisdictions on a downward trajectory; 1,241 FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Nov 10)

Nationwide Testing: 157,788,123 cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Nov 10)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally (CDC Update, as of Nov 11)

COVID-19 Confirmed Cases:

United States: 10,170,846 (+134,383)

o Worldwide: 51,251,715 (+490,478)



Worldwide: 1,270,930 (+8,570)



- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring







