What is the Nationwide Cybersecurity Review?

The Nationwide Cybersecurity Review (NCSR) is a no-cost, anonymous, annual self-assessment designed to measure gaps and capabilities of state, local, tribal and territorial governments' cybersecurity programs. It is based on the National Institute of Standards and Technology Cybersecurity Framework (NIST CSF), and is sponsored by the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and the Multi-State Information Sharing and Analysis Center® (MS-ISAC®). This assessment is a strategic risk management level assessment without in-depth technical questions, making it feasible for all information security professionals to complete.

We hope your organization has the opportunity to participate in 2020, and provide valuable cybersecurity input from members of the Water ISAC!

Please note, an eligible organization must be a public entity within a state, local, tribal, or territorial government.

The NCSR question set was built upon the NIST CSF Core, with some minor alterations. The Core consists of a collection of cybersecurity-related activities organized into five main functions: Identify, Protect, Detect, Respond, and Recover.

NCSR Benefits

- Receive metrics to identify your organization's cybersecurity maturity gaps.
- Develop a benchmark to gauge year-to-year progress.
- Anonymously measure your results against your peers.
- Obtain resources and services that can help you mitigate gaps in your maturity.
- Nationally, aggregate NCSR data provides a foundational understanding of SLTT cybersecurity posture to help drive policy, governance, and resource allocation.
